Charles M. Schulz Award

- Honors an outstanding college cartoonist.
- Open to any undergraduate student cartoonist whose cartoons were published in print or online in 2009 by a college newspaper or college magazine in the United States or its territories. Student must be enrolled in same college for the 2009-2010 school year.
- Entry should include 10 – 20 representative samples (one per page) on 8 1/2" x 11" paper. Do not send originals. Type or print on the front of each page your name and name of the college publication in which the work appeared. Tearsheets (8 1/2" x 11") are acceptable, but we recommend simple, clear photocopies. Submit the samples in a folder.
- Cartoons may be panels, strips and/or editorial cartoons/illustrations.
- Entry must include a written statement (250 words or less) by the cartoonist outlining his or her goals in cartooning.
- Entry form should be completed and secured to the front of the folder. A duplicate of the completed form should be paper-clipped to the front of the entry. Entry form may be copied.
- One entry per student.
- Entries will not be returned and may be collected in educational and research archives.
- Entries must be postmarked by January 30, 2010 and received by the judging date. Scripps Howard Foundation is not responsible for entries received too late for judging.
- No entry fee. Prize is \$10,000 and a trophy.
- The award for 2009 will be presented to the winner at an awards dinner on April 23, 2010 in Tampa, Fla. Winner agrees to attend.
- Winner will be announced March 12, 2010 by major media outlets and posted on the Foundation's Web site www.scripps.com/foundation
